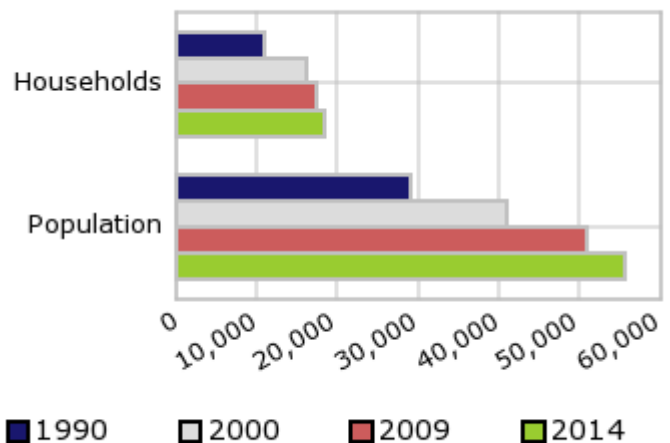
Executive Summary Report with Charts

Population Demographics

The number of households in the study area in 1990 was **11,136** and changed to **16,176** in 2000, representing a change of **45.3%**. The household count in 2009 was **17,610** and the household projection for 2014 is **18,443**, a change of **4.7%**.

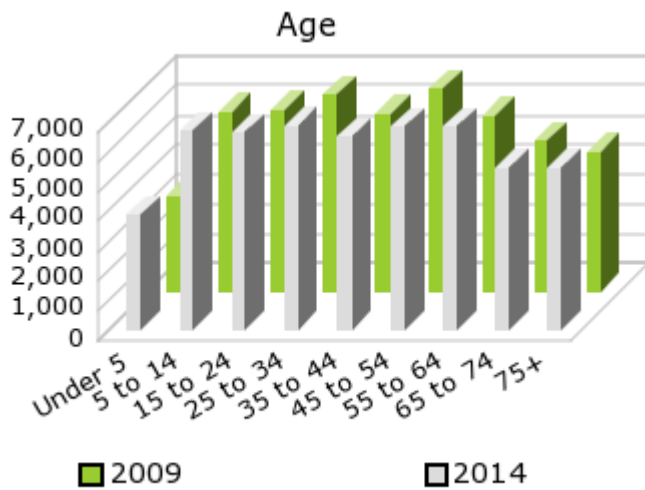
The population in the study area in 1990 was **28,981** and in 2000 it was **41,100**, roughly a **41.8%** change. The population in 2009 was **50,930** and the projection for 2014 is **55,587** representing a change of **9.1%**.

Population by Age

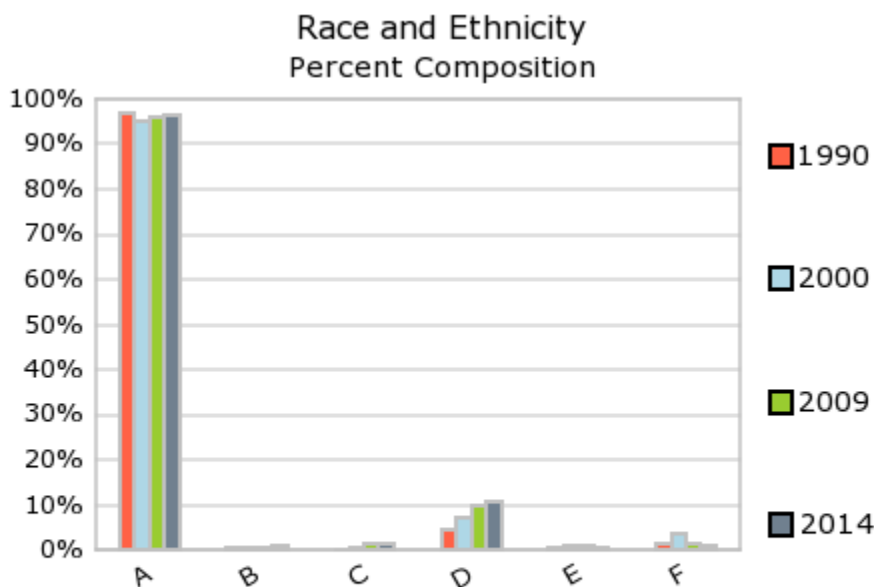


In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **36.9**, and in 2000, it was **41.5**. The median age in 2009 is **40.6** and it is predicted to change in five years to **40.2** years. In 2009, females represented **50.8%** of the population with a median age of **42.0** and males represented **49.2%** of the population with a median age of **39.1** years. In 2009, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 45 to 54** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **18 to 24** years.

In 2009, the predominant race/ethnicity category in this study area is **White**. The race & ethnicity category least represented in this geography is **Asian or Pacific Islander**.

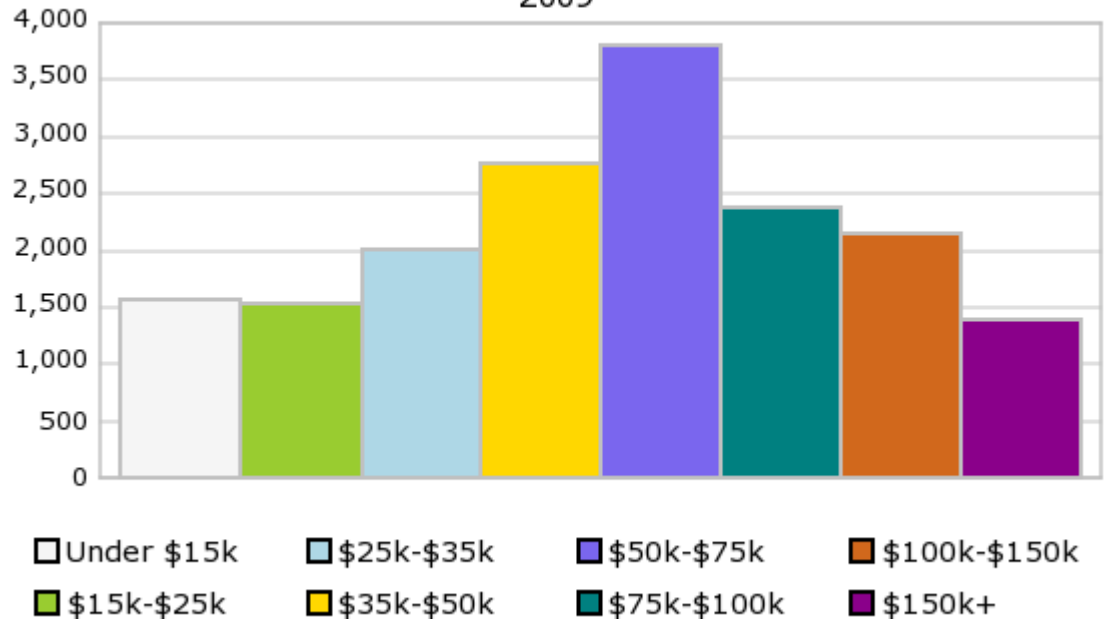
